- Quarterly magazine, mailed to members

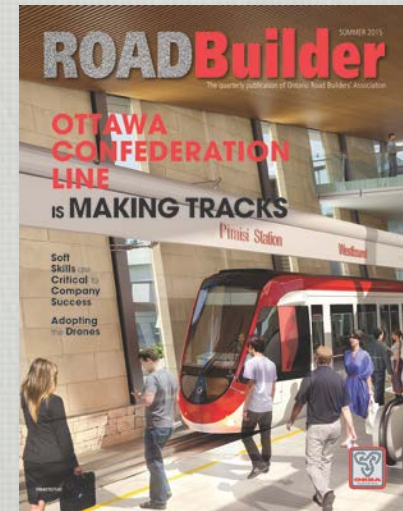

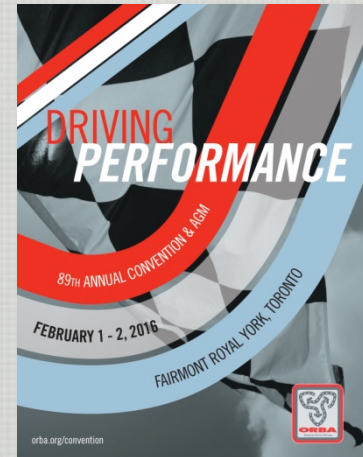

Municipal Contractor Membership Category

- Must not perform MTO work as a general or sub contractor
- Minimum two years, uninterrupted, operating experience
- No history of bankruptcy, fraud or similar breaches for the last three years
- Be in compliance with all applicable laws, rules and regulations and be duly qualified and licensed to do business in each jurisdiction which requires such qualification or licensing
- Agree to ORBA code of ethics
